

# Time Signatures - $\frac{2}{4}$

In  $\frac{2}{4}$  time there are two beats in each measure.  
The quarter note gets one beat.

Rhythmic values

- An eighth note ( $\text{♪}$ ) = 1/2 beat
- A quarter note ( $\text{♩}$ ) = 1 beat
- A half note ( $\text{♩}$ ) = 2 beats
